June is high season for hotels in Helsinki, please book well in advance.

Airport to Helsinki

A taxi service from Helsinki-Vantaa airport to Kumpula can cost around 35 euros and to Helsinki City centre around 45 euros.

There are two regular bus connections running between the airport and the main railway stations in Helsinki. Bus number 615 leaves every 15 minutes from T1 (platform 2) and T2 (platform 21). Tickets are around 5,00 euros and can be purchased from the driver. The average journey takes about 35 minutes.

The Finnair City Bus takes you from airport to central railway station. The fare is 6,30 €, and it runs every 20 minutes, between 05:45 and 01:10 daily. This bus leaves from T2 (platform 10) and stops at T1 (platform 1)

How to go to FMI

From the central railway station:

Tram number 6 (to North) and several "blue" buses, such as No.55, 71, 71v, 75, 77 have a stop in front of the central railway station. The tram number 6 has also a stop in front of hotel Cumulus Kaisaniemi.

Take the tram number 6 northwards to Kumpula (terminal point "Kauppakeskus Arabia"). Normally it takes about 15-20 minutes for the tram to get from downtown to Kumpula.

From the tram 6 stop or bus stop cross the road "Kustaa Vaasan tie", then walk up the hill. (See attachment)
